

### 3/19/18 Friends of Wompatuck Meeting

Meeting opens 7:04 PM

1. Map – Lars Ahlzen shows off the newly printed FoW Wompatuck map.
2. Minutes- Bill Boles mentioned that the minutes had been sent after the last meeting. Minutes approved unanimously.
3. Bike Stand – Timothy Friedmann showed off the art work for the bike stand.
4. Project Updates – Brad Sands mentioned that there were not yet permits for the South Field project. The Visitor's Center is being painted by a volunteer group. The campground electrification project is underway. Camping season for non-electric sites will open on 5/17. Electric sites will open after the work is done, probably in June.
5. Steve Gammon has talked to Susan Kane about the South Field Permit and the Playground proposal. He will follow up. It's possible that Conservation Trust monies can be used for the planning documents. To see a good example of a playground check out the one in North Scituate near the MBTA parking lot.
6. Rentals – Brad mentioned that Reserve America will be the contact to rent a meeting room at Wompatuck.
7. Wompy Warriors – Due to ground conditions there has not yet been any team practice sessions. Brad noted that no permit had been applied for the 5/12 event.
8. Old Business – Wayne Strohm opened a discussion of bunker problems. Many have openings and one in particular poses a current hazard. The problem is under review. The Army Corps of Engineers should be involved in the fix.
9. New Business – Bill Boles reported that the Kids PMC has new leadership and that the event will be held on June 10<sup>th</sup>.
10. Vernal Pools – Steve Gammon reported that there would probably be three new certified vernal pools in Wompatuck.
11. Water Fountain – After a discussion a motion was made to fund a new water fountain for the Visitor's Center for up to \$500. Vote Unanimous
12. Wells – Brad mentioned the need to identify old wells in Wompatuck and the need for them to be capped. Steve Gammon will assist.
